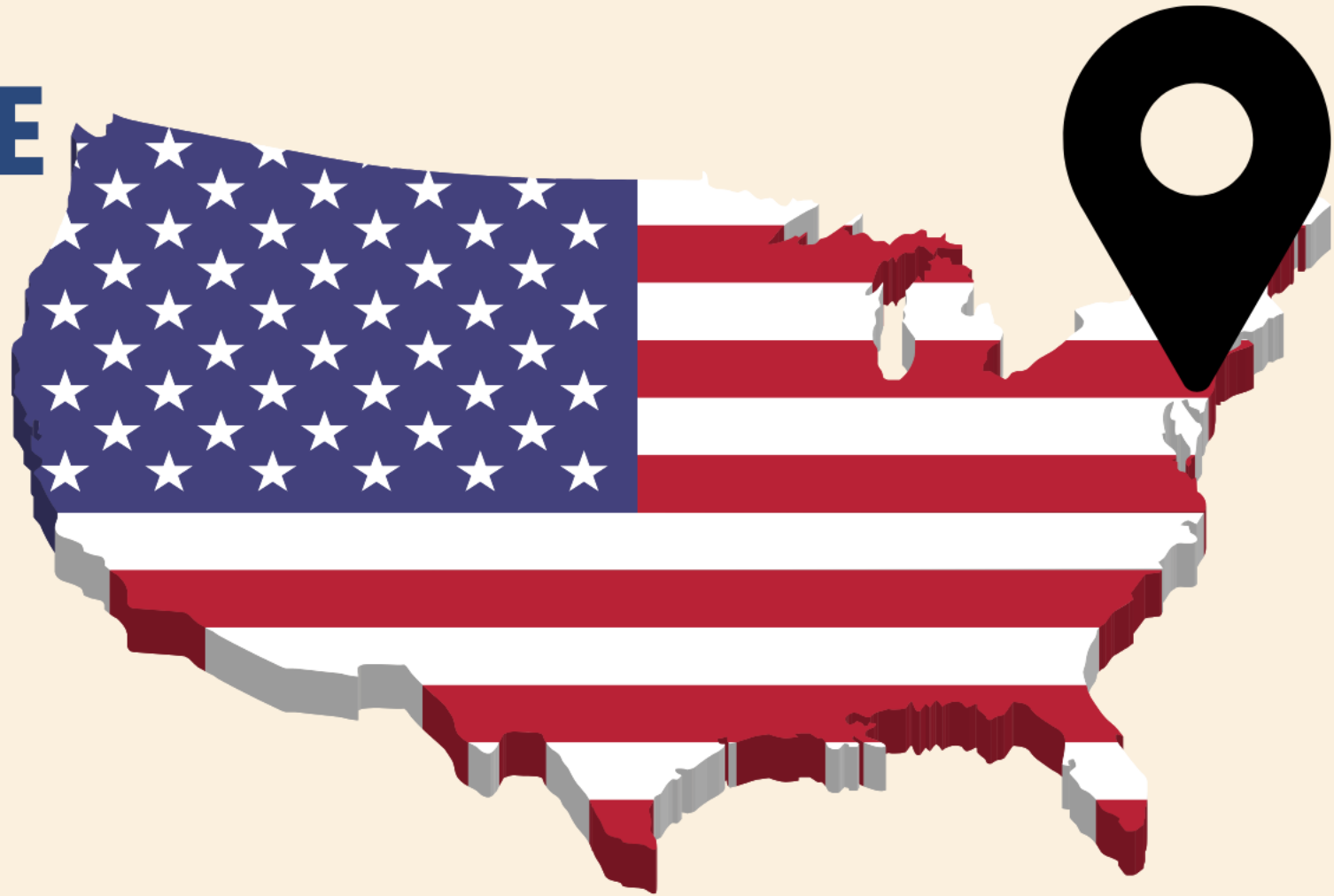

- li>• 🕯️ Climb to the crown





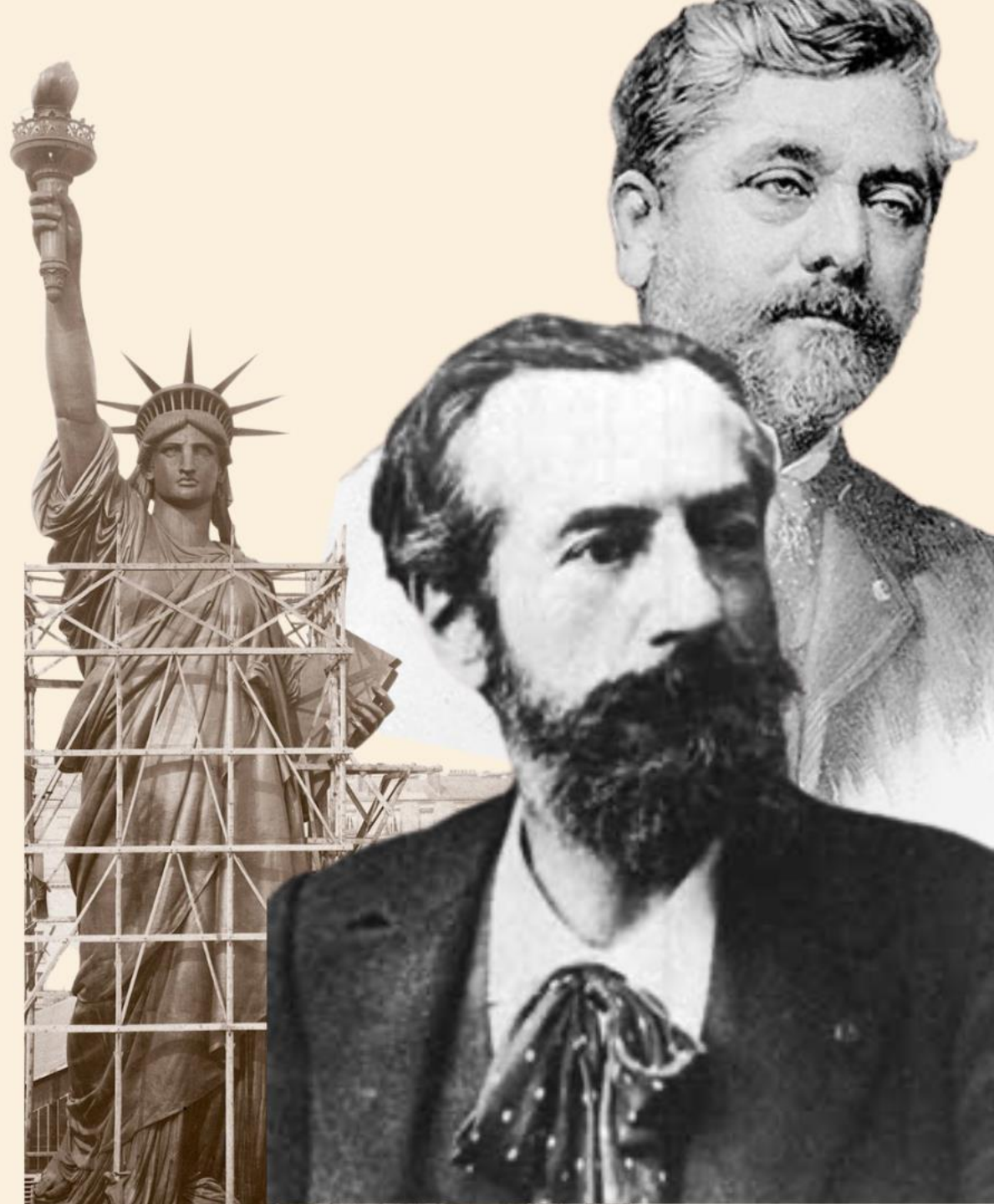
WHY IS IT SPECIAL?

- Symbol of freedom and democracy
- Gift from France to the USA
- Dedicated in 1886
- Welcomed many immigrants to New York
- Accessible only by ferry
- One of the most famous landmarks in the world
- About 3.7 million visitors per year



THE STATUE OF LIBERTY

- Who made it? Frédéric Auguste Bartholdi
- When was it built? 1875–1884
- How did it get to Liberty Island? It came by ship in many pieces and was put together there.
- Iron structure by Gustave Eiffel
